ORDINANCE No. 158719

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with Larson's Marine Service, Inc. to furnish materials and labor for replacing the floating walk and dock at Cathedral Park for the Bureau of Parks and Recreation; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrant(s); and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Larson's Marine Service, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder for the Cathedral Park floating walk and dock project.
- 2. Funds are available in the Fiscal Year 1986-87 Park Bureau Budget.
- 3. Award of contract to said bidder for completing said project has been recommended and approved by the Commissioner of Public Affairs.

Now, Therefore, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner of Public Affairs are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the project described in Section 1 herein in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrant(s) chargeable to the 1986-87 Park Bureau Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
- Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the project may result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of the completed project at an early date; Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
