ORDINANCE NO. 158749

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Good Samaritan Hospital and Medical Center to construct, use and maintain a cast-in-place concrete building extension in and under the street area of NW Northrup Street between NW 21st Avenue and NW 22nd Avenue, at a fee of \$455, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Good Samaritan Hospital, 1015 NW 22nd Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97210, has requested permission to construct, use and maintain a cast-in-place concrete building extension in and under the street area of NW Northrup Street between NW 21st Avenue and NW 22nd Avenue adjacent to the permittee's property (Lots 14 & 15, Block 300, Couch's Add).
- 2. The building extension is needed to provide for electrical service to the building being constructed on the permittee's adjacent property, Block 300, Couch's Add (Building Permit application #3666 for 1985).
- 3. That the plan showing the location for the building extension, attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A" has been approved by the City Engineer.
- 4. The desired building extension, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is granted to Good Samaritan Hospital and Medical Center, permittee, to construct, use and maintain the cast in place concrete building extension described in Section 1-1 above and located as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A", attached to and by reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) This permit is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by the City Code or Ordinances for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provisions of any City Code, Ordinance, or the City Charter, except as herein stated.
 - (2) This permit is revocable at any time in the event the public's need requires it and no expenditure of money hereunder, lapse of time, or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right. Immediately upon the expiration of this permit, or upon its sooner revocation by the Council, the permittee shall remove said installations from the street area as required by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.

- (3) The permittee shall pay the permit fee of \$455 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.
- (4) Before construction begins, the permittee shall obtain from the Traffic Engineer his requirement as to hours of work, traffic control, and the placing of necessary signs and barricades.
- (5) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and cost of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows:

Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled, or for any other reason becomes inoperative.


- (6) This permit is a burden upon the property and runs with the land, and will require insurance with limits of coverage that will meet the maximum requirements for liability of a public body as set forth in ORS 30.270 or as it may be required by subsequent amendment and naming the City, its officers, agents and employees as additional insured.
- (7) If during construction under this permit it becomes necessary or expedient to modify the location or plan for the building extension, the permittee shall first obtain the approval of the City Engineer on revised plans filed with the City Engineer. One copy of the approved plan showing the change shall be filed by the City Engineer with the City Auditor to become part of this Ordinance.
- (8) The permittee shall reimburse the City for the cost of filing by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Records Division of Multnomah County.
- Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a document which has been approved by the City Attorney accepting the terms and conditions hereof. This Ordinance shall be automatically revoked without further consideration by the Council if the acceptance together with documents and fees required are not on file with the City Auditor within sixty (60) calendar days of the passage of this Ordinance.
