ORDINANCE No. 158781

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to furnish materials and labor for construction of the Cherry Park Wastewater Pumping Station for the Bureau of Environmental Services; authorizing a contract, subject to Environmental Protection Agency approval; authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for the construction of the Cherry Park Wastewater Pumping Station Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office.
- b. The Commissioner of Public Works and the Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder, subject to Environmental Protection Agency approval, for the project described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with the Plans and Specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1986-87 Sewage Construction Fund Budget, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this project could delay completion of the project on schedule with associated sewer projects; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
