ORDINANCE NO. 158783

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of four warrants in various amounts to individuals in settlement of claims which have been investigated by the Committee on Claims and approved by the City Council, providing for release, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:
