

Ordinance No. 16463.

An Ordinance to establish the Grade of 30th Street, in the City of Portland.

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1: That the Grade of the center line of 30th Street in the City of Portland, be and the same is hereby established at the points hereinafter named, as follows:

At the center line of Vaughn Street at 79.0 feet

" " " " " Wilson " " 55.0 "

" " " " " Roosevelt " " 38.0 "

" a point 95 ft. north of the
north line of Roosevelt " " 35.0 "

above the base of City grades, the same being the original establishment of a grade.
