Administrative Rules Adopted by Bureau Pursuant to Rule-Making Authority ARB-PSF-5.02

Section 1 - Bureau Initiated Complaints:

- 1. Upon opening a Bureau-initiated complaint investigation assigned to IAD, IAD will forward its intake worksheet to the IPR Director and IPR staff will assign an IPR/IAD case number for use by IAD.
- 2. After the IAD investigation is complete and IAD has forwarded the investigation results to the appropriate commanding officer for review and recommendations, IAD may forward a copy of the summary investigative report to the IPR Director for review and comment, as appropriate.
- 3. IAD will advise the IPR Director of the Bureau's findings.
- 4. As chapter 3.21 of Portland City Code does not apply to Bureau initiated complaints, participation in this procedure is discretionary on the part of the Portland Police Bureau.
