# RESOLUTION No. 34561

34561

Amend Waterfront Park policies to allow a Japanese American Historical Garden in Waterfront Park north of the Burnside Bridge. (Resolution)

WHEREAS, in August 1975 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 31595 which provided policies and procedures for developing Waterfront Park; and

WHEREAS, in March 1983 the Council adopted Resolution No. 33358 which provided new policies, procedures and priorities for planning and development in Waterfront Park which supercedes Resolution No. 31595; and

WHEREAS, Waterfront Park Procedure No. 1 requires that "any proposed changes or additions to the park shall be clearly within these adopted policies. If not, the policies must first be amended by the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, in April 1989 the Council adopted a policy on placing memorials in public parks; and

WHEREAS, the proposed memorial conforms with the criteria as established in the memorial policy; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1989, the Metropolitan Arts Commission's Percent Advisory Committee recommended approval of the Japanese American Historical Garden; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Portland as follows:

1. Waterfront Park policy No. 4 is amended with the addition of the following:

"A memorial dedicated to the history of the Japanese-Americans and the value of civil liberties shall be located north of the Burnside Bridge."


