WHEREAS, the Engineer of the City of Portland, Oregon, on May 23, 1989, filed with the Auditor of said City plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of N Dekum Street and the construction of sumps, be it RESOLVED that the Council of said City finds the same to be satisfactory and does hereby approve and adopt the same and determines the boundaries of the district benefited and to be assessed for said improvement to be as herein given; that the Council declares its purpose and intention to improve said street in accordance with the set of plans, specifications and estimates which is endorsed as follows: PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE, and the PROBABLE TOTAL COST of the improvement, including all items of material and work required in improving N Dekum Street from the west line of N Delaware Avenue to the east line of N Boston Avenue and the construction of sumps; together with a map and description of the boundaries of the proposed assessment district to be benefited and assessed therefor; that the cost of said improvement shall be assessed as provided by the Charter and Ordinances of said City upon the property specially and peculiarly benefited thereby. which property is hereby determined and declared to be all the lots, parts thereof and parcels of land within the district of said City described as follows:

Beginning at the NW crnr of Lt 23, Blk 1, Multnomah Pk; thence S'ly to the SW crnr of Lt 22 of said Blk 1; thence E'ly to the SE crnr of Lt 25 of said Blk 1; thence N'ly to the NE crnr of Lt 6, Blk 19, Delashmutt and Oatman's Little Homes No. 3; thence W'ly to the NW crnr of said Lt 6; thence N'ly to a point along the E/L of Blk 20 of said Delashmutt and Oatman's Little Homes No. 3 which is 60' N of the N/L of N Dekum St; thence W'ly along a line parallel to the N/L of N Dekum St to a point on the W/L of said Blk 20; thence S'ly to the SW crnr of said Blk 20; thence SE'ly to the point of beginning.

That the Council of said City does hereby determine that the character of said improvement to be laid and made shall be as follows:

1st: Clearing & Grubbing;

Excavation, Common; 2nd:

3rd: Excavation, Concrete;

4th: By grading street to proper subgrade;

5th: Sawcut Concrete;

6th: Concrete Sidewalk (4");

7th: Concrete Driveway (6");

8th: Curb, Concrete; 9th: Asphalt Dwy. Conn. (Std. Pl. 3-138); Improving the roadway with asphalt concrete Class "C," 10th: 1-1/2" thick, on asphalt concrete Class "B," 1-1/2" thick, on a crushed rock base 6" thick: AC Skinpatch: 11th: 12th: 10" CSP with Class "C" Bedding; 13th: Sedimentation Manhole (10'); 14th: Precast Sump (30'); 15th: Sump Capacity Test; 16th: Standby for Sump Test Results; 17th: Remove Inlet; 18th: Inlet, Double; 19th: Permanent Sewer Plug; 20th: Adjust MH or sump; Rain Drain (3"); 21st: 22nd: Water for Dust (1000's Gallons); 23rd: Install Funding Sign; 24th: Geotextile Fabric;

That the estimated cost of said improvement in accordance with said plans, specifications and estimates is \$37,226.70; that the advertising costs, progress payment interest, and a fee for engineering and superintendence will be added to the final cost in accordance with the provisions of the Code of the City of Portland; that the City's share is total cost less property owner's share; that the dates for starting and completing said improvement shall be as shown in the "Special Specifications," and that said Auditor is hereby directed to give notice as provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Portland.
