HEARINGS OFFICER'S ORDER

APPEAL OF ROBERT STEPP

CASE NO. 1080195

DESCRIPTION OF VEHICLE: Nissan Truck (OR WGV082)

DATE OF HEARING: July 15, 2008

The Hearings Officer, on substantial evidence and based upon the record as a whole and receiving Exhibits 1 through 10 into the record without objection, finds as follows:

The towing officer's report stated that the appellant's vehicle was towed because the Oregon Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) indicated that the driver's license was suspended (Exhibit 8).

The appellant stated that the license was suspended because of a clerical error done in another jurisdiction. The City Code authorizes an officer to tow a vehicle if the officer has probable cause to believe the driver is driving with a suspended license. In this case, the DMV information informing the officer that the driver's license was suspended gave the officer such probable cause, even if the information proved later to be incorrect.

Given these circumstances, this was a valid tow. Please note the relevant City Code sections below concerning this matter.

16.30.220 Towing Without Prior Notice.

(Amended by Ordinance Nos. 165980, 170912, 176352, and 176442, effective May 1, 2002.) Any authorized officer may, without prior notice, order a vehicle towed, when:

K. A police officer has probable cause to believe that the vehicle's operator has committed any of the following offenses:

2. Driving while suspended or revoked (ORS 811.175 or ORS 811.182);

Therefore, it is ordered that all towing and storage charges against the vehicle shall remain the responsibility of the vehicle's owner.

This order may be appealed to a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to ORS 34.010 et seq.
