The Hearings Officer, on substantial evidence and based upon the record as a whole, finds as follows:

Marie Chase appeared and testified. Exhibits 1 through 9 were admitted, which includes the report of the officer who ordered the tow. The Hearings Officer finds the officer's report to be credible.

Ms. Chase's vehicle was towed on July 30, 2008 at 2:22 pm from SW 11<sup>th</sup> near the intersection of SW Gibbs. The no parking signage was verified by the City of Portland Parking Enforcement on July 28, 2008 at 8:24 am, more than 24 hours in advance of the tow. Portland City Code 16.30.210D requires that the temporary no parking signs be placed 24 hours in advance of the tow.

Therefore, it is ordered that all towing and storage charges against the vehicle shall remain the responsibility of the vehicle's owner.

This order may be appealed to a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to ORS 34.010 et seq.
