

**Resolution No. 36679**

Accept a joint City of Portland-Multnomah County taskforce report on options for providing animal services in the City (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland contracts with Multnomah County, through an Intergovernmental Agreement, to provide animal services in the City; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County can no longer fund the level of animal services in the City that meets the growing expectations and demands from the citizens of Portland; and

WHEREAS, the Portland City Council in January 2008 directed the Bureau of Development Services to convene a joint committee with the County Animal Services Division to study the feasible options for providing animal services in the City that protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Portland City Council accepts the joint city-county taskforce report (Exhibits A); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Portland City Council directs the Bureau of Development Services to convene a joint Animal Services Implementation Team with the County Animal Services Division to design a plan to implement proposals of the joint city-county taskforce for implementation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Animal Services Implementation Team shall report its findings to the City Council and County Commission no later than June 30, 2009.


