Here are some arguments that may help in your effort to thwart the proposed name change.

- Name changes are far more complicated than simply repainting street signs and reprinting letterhead stationary. Millions of GPS systems are in use in cars and vehicles today throughout the world. The maps used by all these systems become inaccurate when street names are changed for trivial reasons. The GPS guidance systems in all these vehicles use the established names to create directional instructions for drivers. When the street name get changed, the change may be entered in one GPS mapping system but not another one. Someone with a copyrighted mapping system programmed in California will most likely be using a different system from a visitor from British Columbia.

Few people are aware of how these GPS mapping systems interact. An erroneous software entry on a street name or a delayed street directory update may result in thousands of lost drivers and, more importantly, delivery trucks, resulting in thousands of dollars of lost productivity and wasted hours of driving.

This is in addition to ALL the printed street maps of Portland everywhere suddenly becoming inaccurate. Changing the names of small side streets may not cause major problems, but changing the names of major streets that intersect for symbolic reasons is foolish. A trucking company in Kansas City sends a cross-country driver to Portland Oregon to make a deliveries in Portland OR. One is an address near the corner of NE Portland Blvd and NE Interstate. They allocate one hour off the highway for the shipment to be dropped before the next just-in-time delivery. But neither the GPS nor the maps being used by the driver have been upgraded and the driver gets hopelessly lost.

It's not 1965 anymore. A strategy of constant street-name changing in a city may have many unanticipated consequences in the internet age that are beyond the comprehension of those who are forcing the changes in the names of major transportation arteries for symbolic and trivial reasons. This is not just a local issue.

If people seriously wanted to honor César Chavez, they would develop robots to pick crops and get the farmworkers out of the hot and brutal fields. Former food pickers could become the new robot picker technicians and these robots could be named 'Little Césars'. Wasn't that Mr. Chavez's whole point? To create a better life for his people by getting out of the dead-end feudalistic serf-labor jobs that all crop picking has always been?

I did crop-picking during summers as a teenager; it's no fun, it's no life. I'd rather be a robot technician any day.



My name is Don Wells, I am the owner of Fix My Dead PC, a small computer repair business which is located on Southeast 39th Avenue at Lincoln Street. It is absurd to think that at a time when the nation is in a recession and the state, cities, and counties of Oregon are in no better shape that it is being considered to waste money renaming streets. The untold amount of money that you must consider is beyond the immediate impact of signage and labor; how about the amount that the individual businesses will be responsible for in reworking their letterhead, business cards, advertisements, etc, or that of the individual residents with their addresses on their checks, personal letterhead, return address labels, etc? And what of the various billing companies/agencies of the residents and businesses of 39th Ave being required to waste time, money, and effort in changing their files to send their bills and such to their customers? Or is this a covert method of stimulating the economy by wasting money?

The fact that 39th Ave doesn't meet the criteria of being named a boulevard, per the definition of boulevard, is yet another point in considering the wasting of time, money, and effort to rename it. If there must be something named to honor Cesar Chavez then the most responsible thing would be to name something being built/established or, if a street MUST be renamed, the portion of N.E. 82nd that veers off to the airport is a much better option — it is indeed a Boulevard (definition: boulevard (often abbreviated Blvd) is usually a wide, multilane arterial thoroughfare, divided with a median down the center).
