Approve proposed formation of special district, the Tigard-Tualatin Aquatic District (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the Tigard-Tualatin School District (TTSD) has determined that it is not economically feasible for TTSD to operate the aquatic centers at Tigard High School and Tualatin High School (the Aquatic Centers) on a long-term basis; and

WHEREAS, concerned citizens seek the formation of Tigard-Tualatin Aquatic District (TTAD), a special parks and recreation district formed pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Oregon Revised Statutes for the purpose of operating the Aquatic Centers; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of TTAD are proposed to be the same as the boundaries of TTSD and include territory within the cities of Tigard, Tualatin, Durham, and King City as well as a small amount of territory within the City of Portland; and

WHEREAS, ORS 198.720(1) requires certified copies of resolutions approving the petition to form the district from the governing bodies of those cities with territory within the proposed district; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Tigard, Tualatin, Durham, and King City have approved resolutions approving the petition to form TTAD; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Portland approves the petition to form the Tigard-Tualatin Aquatic District attached as Exhibit 1.
