## ORDINANCE No. 183079

\* Accept a \$25,000 grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division, Photo Radar in Highway Work Zones Project for overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division will make an award as part of a pilot project for photo radar enforcement on state highway work zones in accordance with ORS 810.438 and 439 Sec 4 in order to substantiate the positive or other effects of using such technology to change driver behavior.
- 2. The City wishes to accept ODOT funding for the Photo Radar Pilot Project on state highway work zones. The grant period is July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2011.
- 3. ODOT will reimburse the City a maximum of \$25,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for officer and sergeant overtime worked on the Photo Radar project.
- 4. This grant requires \$4,858 in cash match, which will be funded with existing Police Bureau FY10 and FY11 General Fund appropriation within the Traffic Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation in the amount of \$25,000.
- b. The FY 2009-2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
