## ORDINANCE No. 183090

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to provide civil forfeiture proceeds from drug crimes to the County. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The 2009 Legislature enacted comprehensive forfeiture legislation in response to the passage of Ballot Measure 53, which amended the Oregon Constitution to clarify under what circumstances civil forfeiture can be undertaken.
- 2. The law requires City agencies who seize property for forfeiture to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the county in which property was seized to provide a portion of the forfeiture proceeds to the county.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive Multnomah County and the City of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
