LIBERTY RATION IN PARADISE

Since 1918 the Bolsheviks have rationed liberty in "the Peoples' Paradise" by taking the following steps:

- liquidating over 255,000 members of the clergy.
- establishing the world's largest penal population (between three and 15 million).
- reduced the number of churches from 46,457 to 4,225 throughout all Russia.
- starved 4,800,000 Ukrainians during the enforced famine of 1932-33.
- executed 3,000 in Karachay and Balkaria.
- murdered 400,000 during the Ukrainian purge of 1937.
- massacred 9,500 Ukrainians in Vinnitsa.

Recent trials and hearings into Nazi cases of mass extermination and liquidation have focused the attention of the world on a problem that has been with us since the conquests of the biblical Nimrod.

Adolph Eichman was convicted of personally ordering the deaths of millions of Jews. His name has become anathema.

As the conquistadors swept across Mexico and Peru in the 16th century they often executed inhabitants of entire villages and cities.

The United Nations has defined genocide as, "a deliberate policy involving acts intended to destroy in whole or in part a national, ethnic, racial or religious group."

The U.N. further describes acts characterized as entailing genocide as follows: "killing members of the group, causing serious bodily or mental harm to members, deliberately inflicting...conditions of life calculated to bring about its physical destruction in whole or in part..."

When Khrushchev says,

"we must push them to their grave," he is referring to the free world collectively as a system and also to each individual member of the free world. With this statement he pledged himself and the Communist movement to a policy of genocide--with the entire world as his victim.

Since its succession to the Kremlin throne, mass murder of entire races and ethnic groups has been a very real tool of Communism.

When the people of the "autonomous" republics of Georgia and the Ukraine attempted to use their "right of self-determination and

free development" as guaranteed in the 1917 Declaration of Rights of the People of Russia, the iron mallet of totalitarian Bolshevism quickly stepped in to guide their self-determination along the proper paths and the Red masters did not hesitate to implement the tools of starvation, disease and hot lead.

When the hordes of yellow Reds over-ran China following World War II, at least 30 million people--nearly equal to the combined populations of New York and California--were executed because they refused to fall in

line with the new dynasty. Nikita Khrushchev has earned the titles "Hangman of the Ukraine," and "Butcher of Budapest" because of the roll he played in the murder of 400,000 Ukrainians during WW II and for the quelling of the Hungarian Revolution in 1956.

Leaders of the free world need to quit kidding themselves and admit that Communism is not just another political system.

Remember--the master plan guiding the Kremlin leaders calls for a mass campaign of genocide when they succeed in conquering the nations of the free world.



traced directly to Nikita S. Khrushchev, the peace loving, shoe pounding bear of United Nations fame.

He has rightly earned the titles "Killer of the Kremlin," "Hangman of the Ukraine," and "Butcher of Budapest."

Englishman M. Magride wrote in the May 1933 issue of Fortnightly Review following a visit to the Ukraine in the spring of 1933:

"On one side there were millions of peasants with bodies swollen from hunger; on the other side, soldiers, members of the GPU, carrying out the orders of the dictatorship of the proletariat. They hurled themselves on the region like a pack of locusts and seized everything edible. They shot and hung thousands of peasants, sometimes whole villages; they made of the richest country in the world a melancholy wilderness."

Kremlin students of Lenin are preparing now to turn the United States into a similar "Peoples' Paradise."

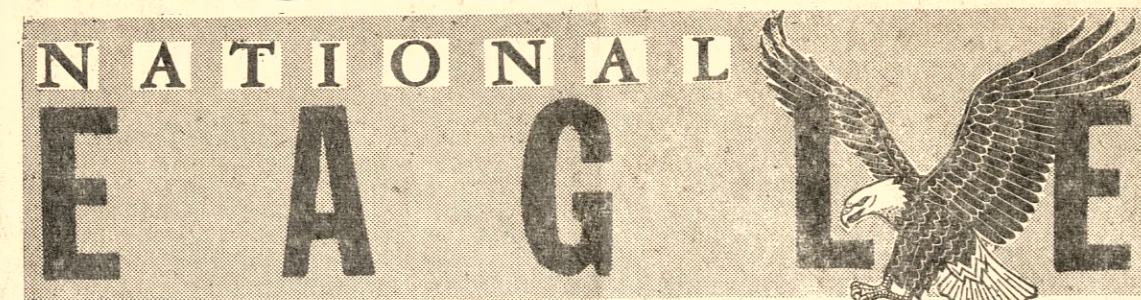

FRANCE RECOGNIZES Red China -- Raises Old Two-China Question

When France changed sides on the question of admitting Red China into the United Nations, attention was again focused on the two China problem.

As a rule the United States and other Western Powers have backed Chiang Kai-shek's exiled government on Formosa as the group speaking for the whole of the Chinese people. On the other hand, the Soviets stand with the Communist regime in Peiping as the ruling body.

To date the U.S. has been successful in its efforts to keep Red China out of the U.N. However, each year Russia argues for Peiping's admission. And each year the vote of the U.N. General Assembly indicates that the U.S. is losing ground.

The only argument that can be offered in support of recognition of Mao Tze-tung's People's Republic of China is that they do in fact rule the people.

Chiang's government on Formosa has several arguments in its favor--all of which are legitimate.

1) Chiang speaks for the people of China. More than 10 million Chinese live on democratic Formosa and he is their voice. But on the mainland there are 650 million Chinese behind a bamboo walled prison with Mao as warden. None of these 650 million has a voice because Mao operates with suppression as the guideline. Chiang does say what his imprisoned countrymen would if they had a voice that could be heard.

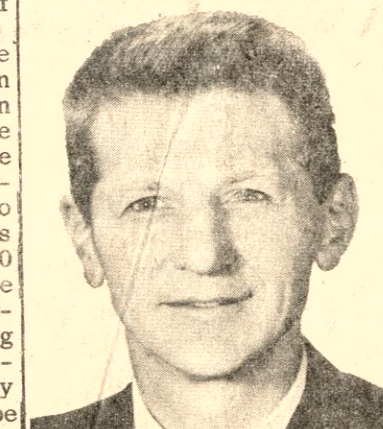
2) Chiang was the popular leader of the people when forced from the mainland by a foreign sponsored murderer obeying a foreign ideology. Mao's band of guerrillas was the aggressor for the international Communist movement and not a spontaneous revolt of the people. Orders, money, and supplies were given by the Communist harigmen in Moscow. Mao falsely represented himself and Communism to the people. He is a traitor to



his own countrymen and cannot represent them while ruling with force and hunger.

3) Chiang has proven his government to be more responsible to the people than the Communist leaders of Peiping.

REDS SMEAR BOSS

Izvestia, the Soviet newspaper edited by Premier Khrushchev's son-in-law, reports that the career of a young engineer rapidly rising in the esteem of the Communist Party, has been cut short because of a smear campaign waged against him by fellow employees.

Michael Odnous was chief engineer in the Ukrainetown of Krivoy Rog. Odnous is described by Izvestia as a serious man, not too much of a mixer, and as one who does not drink or smoke.

His envious enemies, noting these characteristics, began a quiet smear campaign--they spread the rumor that he was a "believer," specifically a Baptist.

Consequently, fellow employees, and his subordinates, gave him the silent treatment and became less responsive to his orders. Odnous finally cracked under the tension and resigned his post.

Izvestia and some public officials conceded he was done an "injustice," but still blame him for "capitulation" (cont. on page 4).

anybody forcing me to hire someone I didn't want."

Concerning sit-ins, protest marches and other demonstrations, he said, "all the street demonstrations in the world, backed up by all manner of civil rights legislation, will not improve the racial situation."

Fuller pointed out that "you" cannot legislate men's thoughts. Yet any Negro who does not think his salvation lies in the civil rights movement is looked down upon by the entire race."

"Negroes must gain economic equality through their own initiative before they can achieve racial equality." He then continued, "the Negro's economic plight was not primarily discrimination so much as it is the Negro's lack of desire to improve his lot."

Fuller suggested that civil rights leaders might better spend their time encouraging Negroes to get off public assistance rolls and into jobs.

"If we don't stop the relief trend," he said, "over 50 per cent of the Negro population will be living on Government reservations within the next 20 years."

Fuller then spoke to the press gathering about the education problem. "It makes little difference whether Negroes obtain education in all-Negro or integrated schools. If a white person gets a good education going to school without colored persons, I can't believe that a colored person can't get a good education without going to school with white persons."

The Chicago Negro then recommended an abandonment of the protest demonstrations and the launching of a public relations campaign "to enhance the Negro image."

Civil Rights ... ARE REDS IN THE MOVEMENT?

The current controversy over the Kennedy-Johnson Civil Rights Bill again raises the question of the Communist conspiracy's relation to the Civil Rights movement in the United States.

Claudia Jones, a deported American Communist residing in England, aptly stated the Communist position in the Civil Rights movement when she delivered a speech before a Red-backed rally in London.

She stated that they regard "the struggle of the American Negro people for civil rights (as) part of the widespread struggle all over the world against colonialism and imperialism."

Before her deportation she was secretary of the Women's Commission of the U.S. Communist Party, educa-

tional director of the Young Communist League, and assistant to Communist leader Elizabeth Gurley Flynn. She voices the opinion of the international Communist movement.

But the question still remains--just how deeply have the Moscow oriented dupes, sympathizers, and party members penetrated the movement?

Ray Cromley of the Newspaper Enterprise Association states, "the Communist Party USA is sending specialized Communists to infiltrate the local branches of the Negro Civil Rights organizations. The infiltrators have been instructed not to take overly prominent roles in civil rights demonstrations for fear they will be investigated and... their identity become known."

Fourteen years ago, Frederick Woltman, authority on Communism, wrote in the New York World-Telegram: "With intent to capture or wreck it, the Communists have set their sights on the largest and most influential Negro organization in America, the NAACP. It has become top priority target of the Communist Party strategy."

Woltman said the Party's first step was to defeat Roy Wilkins for NAACP leadership and replace him with their own man, Earl B. Dickerson. Failing to oust Wilkins from his seat, the Party packed up Dickerson's bags and moved him to the younger, more militant Congress of Racial Equality. He is now on CORE's Advisory Committee.

Since Woltman wrote his article for the New York World-Telegram, Dickerson has become a member of the Board of Directors, NAACP. A list has been compiled of 65 different Communist front organizations to which Dickerson does or has been affiliated.

Another member of CORE's Advisory Committee, Rev. A.J. Muste, has been described by the House Committee on Un-American Activities as the founder of the American Workers Party--"one of the dissenting groups in the Communist

Party, USA."

Louis Budenz, managing editor of the Daily Worker before he resigned from the Party in 1949, stated that "the Mustetes were committed to the idea of overthrowing the U.S. Government by force or violence."

Dr. Goodwin Watson, also a member of the Advisory Committee of the Congress of Racial Equality, has been linked to 82 Communist Front organizations. The House Committee on Un-American Activities referred to him as a "propagandist for

Communism and the Soviet Union."

In 1962 the St. Louis Globe-Democrat revealed that Jack H. O'Dell, alias Hunter Pitts O'Dell (or vice versa), right hand man to Martin Luther King, was also a Communist. A former Merchant Marine sailor O'Dell was expelled from the National Maritime Union for circulation of pro-Soviet petitions and for attacking the government of the U.S.

The Freedom Center does not say that all members of the NAACP, CORE, or other

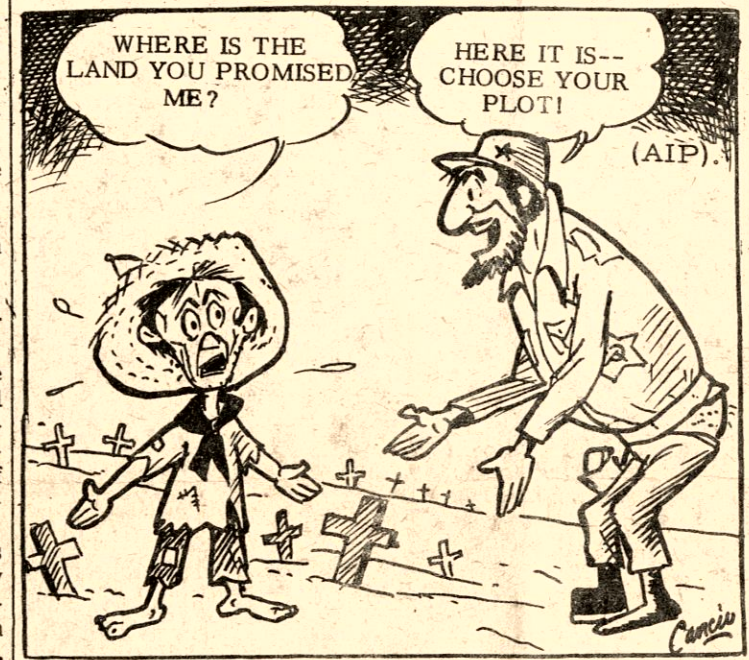
Civil Rights organizations are Communists or Communist sympathizers. However, the above FACTS certainly prove that the Communists are present and will capitalize whenever possible, on the dissension caused by the movements.

PRAYER BAN LOOP HOLE

A 1942 judicial ruling and the constitutional limits on the judiciary are being used by some states to circumvent the Supreme Court's prayer and Bible reading ban for public schools.

Some of the states continuing Bible reading and prayer in public schools include the Carolinas, Alabama, Texas, Mississippi, Montana, Delaware, Kentucky and Vermont.

In 1942 Justice Harlan F. Stone said that a court's judgment "is binding only on the parties to the particular proceedings."

Consequently, a Court decision ruling prayer and Bible reading in New York public schools unconstitutional does not apply to schools in Pennsylvania or Oregon.

Also, the Federal Constitution prohibits the Supreme Court from making laws--it may only determine whether a law has been violated or rule on a specific law's relation to the Constitution.

Florida lets each individual county school board decide whether Bible reading or prayer may be permitted in its county. Hawaii is leaving the decision to the discretion of each teacher.

Great Decisions and Mrs. Dean Follow Red Propaganda Line

On January 19, 1961, Dr. Robert A. Scalapino, professor of political science at the University of California, strode to the podium of the Lloyd Center Auditorium in Portland, Oregon, and said:

"...Communism today is not the ideologically rigid movement envisioned by Marx, Engels and Lenin, or even by Stalin."

"...the U.S. must seek new areas of agreement with Russia."

"...the U.S. public must learn to open its mind to new ideologies."

"...we must no longer be ideologically rigid, but must find new values, new rules."

Dr. Scalapino was lecturing in the "Great Decisions" series sponsored by the Foreign Policy Association.

This left-wing organization was co-sponsored in the Portland area by the World Affairs Council, The Oregonian, KOIN-TV, and radio and civic organizations.

In its 43 years of activity the Foreign Policy Association has consistently promoted the Kremlin line and

justified Communist actions. The FPA maintains that Korea was "liberated" by the USSR in 1945.

In Great Decisions, 1960, No. 7, they stated that "no competent observer has accused Fidel Castro of being a Communist. The Castro program includes none of the major planks of the traditional Communist platform. Farm lands are not being 'collectivized,' nor is 'nationalization' or 'socialization' of private industry part of the Castro program."

Since its founding in 1921, the FPA has won the support of television, radio, newspapers, magazines and other

public service organizations and public officials.

Gov. Mark O. Hatfield, in a message released on January 28, 1962, and printed in The Oregonian, stated, "It is worthy of the widest possible support and participation."

The "brain" behind the FPA and Great Decisions is Mrs. Vera Michele Dean. She is the research director and editor of FPA publications.

Mrs. Dean was born in Petrograd, Russia, in 1903 and came to the U.S. in 1919.

Broadcasters Praised For Anti-Communism

"To the Communists, man is merely a piece of living matter, devoid of soul or spirit, who can be shaped, molded and directed by purposive manipulation."

Dr. Fern Stukenbroeker, a member of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, made this statement before the 20th Annual Convention of the National Religious Broadcasters held in Washington, D.C., earlier this

year.

Dr. Stukenbroeker said that the aim of Communism "is the creation of a Communist man." To substantiate his statement he quoted Nikita Khrushchev as saying "The rearing of a new man is one of the main achievements of the Party."

"The Communists desire to change the very nature of man, to change him from a child of God to an obedient

slave of an atheistic dictatorship," says Dr. Stukenbroeker.

He told the broadcasters that one of the main problems the Communists have in molding men is that of man's faith in God. He said Communism and religion are irreconcilable and the Reds "are doing everything they can to quench the inner flame deep inside man which reflects that he has been created in the image of God."

The FBI agent asked two questions: 1) Can Communism, with its atheistic ideology, persuasion and coercion, remold human nature, make man into something different from what he is now? and 2) Can the purposive manipulation of a totalitarian state liquidate the divine spark in man?

Dr. Stukenbroeker answered both questions with a positive "NO--Communism can never permanently cage the spirit of man."

He said that the religious broadcasters are playing an important part in America's fight against Communism. He said that "by strengthening a man's faith in God, by deepening his spiritual val-

Becker Amendment Gains Momentum

Congressman Frank Becker (R-N.Y.) has introduced one of the first constitutional amendments intended to cancel out the Supreme Court's banning recitation of an official prayer in public schools.

It has been nearly two years since the court handed down its decision, and the issue is still boiling.

In the House of Representatives no fewer than 144 resolutions have been introduced which would amend the Constitution and negate the Court's decision of June 25, 1962.

The controversial ruling centered around a prayer drafted by the New York Board of Regents for recitation at the start of each school day in public schools.

In 1963 the Court forbade states to require Bible reading or the recital of prayers in public schools.

Both decisions were based on the concept of the separation of church and state.

All the resolutions developed

All the resolutions developed in the House have been referred to the Judiciary Committee whose chairman, Democratic Representative Emanuel Celler, also of New York, ordered his staff to conduct a detailed study of the entire question. The report is complete and in the hands of the Judiciary Committee members. Public hearings are to begin soon.

Becker's resolution would say nothing in the Constitution could be construed to prohibit prayers or Bible readings in public schools on a voluntary basis.

In an attempt to speed up the matter, Becker has filed a discharge petition for his amendment. Such a petition is a device aimed at taking

it from the Judiciary Committee's hands and getting it directly on the House floor.

Becker's cause was given a substantial boost February 19th when his amendment received official endorsement from the House Republican Policy Committee.

Becker has predicted that the amendment will pass overwhelmingly if he is successful in getting it to the House floor.

And, according to the Associated Press, no one will argue that point with him.

Free China Strikes Back At DeGaulle-Mao Pact



The Republic of China struck back at French Premier Charles De Gaulle by accusing him of "wishful thinking" and of "encouraging the Chinese Communists in their aggressive activities."

Foreign Ministry spokesman Patrick Pichi Sun said De Gaulle's proposal for the neutralization of Southeast Asia would "play into the hands of the Chinese Communists." Neutralization means surrender by instalments.

The China News, a Formosan daily, says, "De Gaulle did not attempt to conceal the supreme objective of the French--to neutralize the vast Southeast Asian area in cooperation with Peiping. What a pity that De Gaulle, who prides himself on stark realism, should have ventured into such a land of wishful thinking."

"Southeast Asia is in the process of choosing between freedom and the socialist tyranny of the Communists," the daily continued.

It concluded by saying, "any neutralistic solutions are purely temporary and a matter of Communist expediency. If and when the Reds win, any remaining trace of French commercial or cultural influence or interest will vanish in the blink of an eye."

He concluded by saying, "Life in a free society, emphasizing man's search for the truth and the pioneering spirit of the mind gives validity to our American way of life."

Policy Association, Mrs. Dean is affiliated with the American Russian Institute, the Congress of American Women (both cited as Communist by the U.S. Attorney General the American Pushkin Committee, the Golden Book of American Friendship with the Soviet Union, and the International Assembly of Women (all cited as Communist fronts or Communist-influenced by the House Committee on Un-American Activities).

Her pamphlet "Russia: Menace or Promise," was declared pro-Communist by the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee.

In the pamphlet Mrs. Dean states that under the Soviet system, "the Union republics retain the right freely to secede from the Union."

In it she also says that the Soviet ruling council is elected by secret ballot "on the basis of universal, direct and equal suffrage."

The pamphlet defends Stalin's conquest and imprisonment of satellite countries by comparing his actions to our Monroe Doctrine.

It is organizations such as

Vera Dean-run Foreign Policy Association that allows the Communist propaganda mills to brainwash the American public. Rarely is the truth about these organizations brought out by the major media.

Many of the voices behind the soft line toward Moscow are not even Communists themselves (in the sense that Lenin, Stalin and Khrushchev are Communists). But rather they are theorists swept away by the soft, billowy cloud of theoretical communism.

Nowhere can these theorists point and declare, "There is a successful communist society."

In the meantime, the hard core Communists are reaping the benefits of these theoretical sympathizers.

As Dimitrov said at the Lenin School of Political Warfare, "Let our friends do the work. We must always remember that one sympathizer is generally worth more than a dozen militant Communists."
