

Some of the states continuing Bible reading and prayer in public schools include the Carolinas, Alabama, Texas, Mississippi, Montana, Delaware, Kentucky and Vermont.

In 1942 Justice Harlan F. Stone said that a court's judgment "is binding only on the parties to the particular proceedings.'

Consequently, a Court decision ruling prayer and public schools unconstitutional does not apply to schools in Pennsylvania or Oregon.


