# Publisher's open letter to Governor Hatfield:

Governor Mark O. Hatfield State Capital Building Salem, Oregon

May 29, 1964

Dear Governor Hatfield:

I want to call to your attention a shocking University of Oregon publication called NORTHWEST REVIEW. Ihave attached a reproduction from this publication.

This publication in the name of "literary integrity" is fulfilling the long range goals of Joseph Stalin in aiding to demoralize our population which leads to Progressive Surrender to Communism.

While it is clear that Arthur S. Flemming is immediately responsible as President of the University of Oregon, and the State Board of Higher Education is similarly related to this matter, it is significantly clear that you, as Chief of this State are fully responsible for such total irresponsibility within our School system. Your tolerance for Flemming and the garbage that goes in the name of education under him, is in and of itself a weight of condemnation.

If you wanted to govern in all adequacy in this area, you could have asked Herbert Philbrick, famed counterspy serving the FBI within the Communist Party, U.S.A. for 9 years, and he would have told you that the highest penetration of Comsymps in any government branch were to be found under Flemming in the Health, Education and Welfare Department which he headed. Now we have the same fruit ripening in our fair state since "cranberry" Flemming invaded the University of Oregon.

To the informed, the NORTHWEST REVIEW is only a tiny projection of a huge iceberg.

Extreme liberalism not conducive to Republican victory

in November.'

As a minister of the Gospel, I am familiar with some of the students who have come from Christian homes, who after a tour of brainwashing at the University of Oregon and other State schools, have forsaken Christ for "higher criticism". These fatalities are a continuing blight and yet typical of the whole secular system. As a former student at the University of Oregon, I speak from firsthand knowledge. All the bragging you have done locally and abroad about our school system does not wipe away the agony of the parent's heart, nor the loss to the Kingdom of God, nor the offense to the souls of our future leaders.

Jesus said, in Matt. 18:6: "Whose shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

The words of Dr. A. A. Hodge of Princeton Theological Seminary are uncomfortably prophetic:

upon the poisonous slopes of the Caucasus, the Carpathians, the Appenines, the Himalayas,

bestialized beings dance, they dance the dance of pus and blood, of exploded lice, the dance of filthy entrails, they dance to take that and that away from you and to inflict that and that upon you in a word, the sex dance.

Do you wish more sex? do you wish no more sex at all? it is all sex.

And this is the whole question that God go away or that god stay. this is the question that is asked.

They dance the dance of the infamous friction of the fuckery with the women and the union of yoni and vagina.

(I understand nothing of what this means.)

This means that the principle of sexual fecundation which for centuries has been stated with the tongue, the spleen and the feet should now be regulated.

Because it is a question of the departure of God, or of His preservation that confronts the bellyache of our humanity. Because what God is, is all the microbes released by the obscene dances of twisted races and the question arises to find out if we can continue

to let them dance

And dancing is not known and what it can do.

"It is capable of exact demonstration that if every party in the State has the right of excluding from the public schools whatever he does not believe to be true, then he that believes most must give way to him that believes absolutely nothing, no matter in how small a minority the theists or agnostics may be. It is self-evident that in this scheme, if it is consistently and persistently carried out in all parts of the country, the United States' system of national popular education will be the most efficient and wide instrument for the propagation of atheism which the world has ever seen."

Just firing Arthur S. Flemming is insufficient atonement. I join with a host of others in requesting not an innocuous fact finding effort to white-wash these issues, but a thorough shakedown with inter system alterations, and a full report to the taxpayer -- electorate of this State.

Something more than prayer breakfasts and teaching an occasional men's Sunday School class is necessary now. We have had much hearing and the professional approach. Now is the time to become doers of the Word.

I am first appealing to you for some sincere, constructive asistance from your high office.

Finally, Governor, I resent very much the typical political, yet highly questionable attempt recently, of your press secretary, Travis Cross, to induce me to soft peddle my publishing of your liberalleftish leanings, especially when the Communist Press quotes you with such enthusiastic approval --


