## ORDINANCE No. 183494

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$69,960 from the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for sworn personnel overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$69,960 for sworn personnel overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program.
- 2. ODOT awarded the City a grant for sworn personnel overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program in the amount of \$69,960.
- 3. The Traffic Division officers will provide direct law enforcement capability to the courtbased probation program by conducting warrant sweeps.
- 4. ODOT will reimburse the City a maximum of \$69,960 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Police Bureau Traffic Division personnel overtime hours worked assisting the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program.
- 4. This grant requires \$23,320 in cash match, which will be funded with existing Police Bureau FY10 and FY11 General Fund appropriation within the Traffic Division.
- 5. The grant period is November 9, 2009, through September 30, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation in the amount of \$69,960.
- b. The FY 2009-2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217001 Business Area – PL00 Bureau Program Expenses – 512100 = \$42,470 514100 = \$10,000 Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
