

ORDINANCE No. 183893

*Extend contract with the Lloyd Transportation Management Association one year and increase by \$90,000 to provide transportation related services to employees in the Lloyd District (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 36766)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Parking Meter District Policy of 1996 provides guidelines for the distribution of net revenues generated from meter districts that have an adopted parking management plan and revenue allocation plan.
2. The Lloyd District On-Street Parking Management Plan of 1997 called for the installation of meters in the Lloyd District to address commuter parking and parking turnover, and in 2010 the Lloyd Revenue Allocation Committee identified \$90,000 of support for the Lloyd Transportation Management Association as their top priority for allocating meter revenue back to the district.
3. The Lloyd Transportation Management Association is a highly successful public/private partnership that has reduced over 6 million peak hour vehicle miles traveled since 1997, and has substantially increased the number of transit, bicycling and walking trips to the district.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is Optimal.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to amend contract no. 36766 with the Lloyd Transportation Management Association to add one year and \$90,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the contract amendment attached to the original of this ordinance and by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the existing contract expires on June 30, 2010 and the parties wish to continue the work immediately; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


