City Ordinance adopting the report of the City Engineer in the matter of the lateral extension of widening of St. Francis Street from the south line of St. Street to the west line of St. Francis Street.

The City of Richmond does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Common Council of the City of Portland, during the year 1854, extended laterally the lines of North Second Street, near St. James Street to the South side of St. Street, did on the 21st day of August 1854, direct the City Surveyor to survey the same, mark the boundaries thereof, make his report, exhibiting a plat of survey of said proposed extension or widening and its boundaries, and the portions of such lot or parts of lots as were appropriated. And the Surveyor having made the survey, plat, and report, which are satisfactory to the City Council, thereupon the 1st day of Sept. 1854, the City Surveyor of the proposed extension or widening of St. Second Street, near the lot accompanying the same are hereby accepted, of which said report the following is a copy:

In accordance with the 18th article of a resolution adopted at your meeting of August 5, 1878, I have surveyed and marked out the boundaries of the 1st tract containing 24 Acres 39 Rods and here with out set my record chain in the path of the line at the point where the line crosses the road, changing the line.

The ground containing the 64 Grand Stair consists of extending
the boundary survey line 5 feet on the side where the road lies
of 1/4 Grand Stair on the East line of 1/4 Street, and the same with
Grand Stair on the West line. The subject is to be in a little more
than 1/2 mile wide extending 1/2 mile on the West side of the line and
1/2 mile on the East side. The boundary line is to be in a little more
than 1/2 mile wide extending 1/2 mile on the West side of the line and

Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the proposed extension of widening of St Grand Street from the south line of the street to the west line of St Front Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Whereas the City of Portland deeming it expedient to extend the line of St Grand Street from St Front Street to the South line of St Street did on the 21st day of August 1898 direct the City Surveyor to make the same, mark the boundaries thereof, make his report certifying whether or not of said proposed extension or widening and the boundaries, and the portions of such lot or part of lot to be appropriated. And the Surveyor having made the survey, plat and report in which an exhibit is attached to the City Council. Now therefore the report of W. S. Chapman City Surveyor of the proposed extension or widening of St Grand Street and the plat accompanying the same are hereby approved, of which said report the following is a copy.

In accordance with the provisions of a resolution adopted at your meeting of August 21st 1898. I have surveyed and marked out the boundaries of the proposed widening of St Grand Street and hereby with submitt my report showing the parts of lots to be appropriated therefor together with the accompanying plat thereof.

The proposed widening of St Grand Street consists in extending the boundaries thereof five (5) feet on either side thereof between the west line of St Front Street and the South line of St Street, and the same north Grand Street according to the proposed lateral extension will be twenty (20) feet in width extending thirty feet (30) feet on either side of the center line of said street according to the monument locating the same, and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west line of St Grand Street intersects the west line of St Front Street thence along the west line of St Front Street eight and four hundredths (8.4) feet thence southerly along a line parallel to said thirty feet (30) feet from the center line of St Grand Street one thousand eight hundred thirty seven and fifty nine hundredths (1837.59) feet to a point on the south line of St Street thence easterly along the south line of St Street seventy and eight hundredths (70.8) feet: thence northerly along a line parallel to

and thirty five (35) feet from the center line of North Second Street an hundred seven hundred and fifty two and eighty three hundredths (1752.83) feet to the west line of North Front Street thence northerly along the west line of North Front Street one hundred four and forty one hundredths (104.41) feet to the place of beginning containing one hundred and twenty five thousand six hundred and eighty eight and fifty five hundredths (12568.55) feet.

The following described parts of lots in Blocks abutting on North Second Street between "C" Street and North Front Street will be included in, and will have to be appropriated for the proposed widening of North Second Street to wit: The part of each of the following described lots lying between the east line of North Second Street and the east line of the proposed extension thereof being five (5) feet in width between said lines, and fifty (50) feet in length between the North and South lines of the respective lots, and each containing Two hundred and fifty (250) square feet viz:-

The above described part of each of lots No 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 11. Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 12. Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 13. Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 14. Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 15. Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 23. And Lots No 2, 3, 6 in Block "A".

Also that part of each of the following described Lots lying between the west line of North Second Street and the west line of the proposed extension thereof being five feet in width between said lines, and fifty (50) feet in length between the North and South lines of the respective lots, and each containing Two hundred and fifty (250) square feet, viz:-

The above described part of each of lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 19. Lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 18. Lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 17. Lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 16. Lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 14. And Lots No 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 13.

Also that part of fractional Lot No 2 in Block No 11, lying between the east line of North Second Street, the east line of the proposed extension thereof, the north side of said lot and the north line of "C" Street, and containing one hundred and thirty two and eight hundredths (132.8) square feet. Also that part of fractional Lot No 7 in Block "A" lying between the east line of North Second Street, the east line of the proposed extension thereof, the south line of said lot, and the west line of North Front Street, and containing one hundred and ninety seven (197) square feet.

Also that part of fractional Lot No 1 in Block No 20 lying between the west line of North Second Street, the west line of the proposed extension thereof, the north line of said lot and the north line of "C" Street, and containing one hundred seven and twenty three hundredths (107.23) square feet.

Also that part of fractional Lot No 1 in Block "B" lying between the west line of North Second Street, and the west line of the proposed extension thereof, the south line of said lot, and the west line of North Front Street, and containing fifty six and fifty eight hundredths (55.58) square feet.
