

City Council were adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter  
of the lateral extension of reducing the Strand Street from the south line  
of St. Street to the west line of St. Ward Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

The Common Council of the City of Portland, during its session last year, laterally the lines of 30th, Second Street, and 3rd Street, from the South side of 30th Street did on the 21st day of August 1878, direct the City Surveyor to survey the same, mark the boundaries thereof, make his report containing a plan of survey of said proposed extension or addition and its boundaries, and the portions of such lot or part of lot left unoccupied. And the Surveyor having made the survey, plan, and report as aforesaid, shall give to the Common Council, after therefore the session on 11th of October, a copy of the same, of the proposed extension or addition of 30th Street in the City, that accompanying the same are hereby accepted, of which said plan the following is a copy.

In accordance with the law, there is a resolution  
submitted at your meeting of August 5, 1878, as follows:

Commissioned to the service of the State of Tennessee  
in 1861, and during the war to give up the office of Governor  
of the State which left me no time to go to the South West with my  
wife and son, permitted me to visit the West Coast of America, during  
the first year of the Civil War, and made it possible for me to only  
spare four months for the purpose of getting from San Fran-  
cisco to the border of Oregon at the Columbia River, and eight  
months (from May 1861) to have perfectly at my disposal to

advising adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter  
and continuing or reducing of St Ground Street from the south line  
of 1<sup>st</sup> Street to the west line of St Fremont Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Be it resolved by the City of Portland, desiring it expedient to extend  
the line of St. Ground Street from St. Fremont Street to the south  
line of 1<sup>st</sup> Street, did on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1878 direct the City Surveyor  
to cause, marks the boundaries thereof, make his report containing  
a plan of survey of said proposed extension or widening and the boundaries  
and portion of such lot or part of lot to be appropriated. And the Surveyor  
is to make the survey, plan and report so far as satisfactory to the  
Common Council. After wherefore the report of W. S. Chapman City Surveyor  
of the proposed extension or widening of St Ground Street and the lot ac-  
companying the same are hereby adopted, of which said report the following  
is a copy.

In accordance with the provisions of a resolution  
adopted at your meeting of August 21<sup>st</sup>, 1878. I have surveyed and marked  
out the boundaries of the proposed widening of St Ground Street and herby  
with submit my report showing the parts of lots to be appropriated ther-  
eto together with the accompanying plan annex.

The proposed widening of St. Ground Street consists of extending  
the boundaries thereof (3) feet on either side of the north line of  
St. Fremont Street, and the west line of 1<sup>st</sup> Street, and the said north  
Ground Street extending to the proposed lateral or boundary with Boundary  
(30) feet in width extending thirty six (36) feet on either side of the east-  
ward said street according to the measurements reciting the same, and is  
then particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west line of St. Ground Street  
intersecting the west line of 1<sup>st</sup> Street, thence along the west line of  
St. Fremont Street eight and one hundredths (8 1/100) feet southwesterly  
along a line parallel to said street (36) feet from the north side  
of St. First Second Street one thousand eight hundred thirty seven and eight  
hundredths (1837 8/100) feet to a point in the south line of 1<sup>st</sup> Street  
thence easterly along the south line of 1<sup>st</sup> Street, southwesterly and eight  
hundredths (8/100) feet; thence northerly along a line parallel to

and thirty five (35) feet from the center line of North Second Street measured seven hundred and fifty two and eighty three hundredths (752.83) feet to the West line of North Front Street. Thence northerly along the west line of North Front Street, one hundred four and forty one hundredths (104.41) feet to the place of beginning containing one hundred and twenty five thousand nine hundred, sixty eight and fifty five hundredths (125,685.55) feet.

The following described parts of lots, in Blocks abutting on North Second Street between "A" Street and North Front Street will be included in and will have to be apportioned for the proposed widening of North Second Street to wide the part of each of the following described lots lying between the east line of North Second Street and the East side of the proposed extension being five (5) feet in width between said lines and fifty (50) feet in length between the North and South lines of the respective lots, and each containing Two hundred and fifty (250) square feet viz:-

The above described part of each of lots Nos 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 11, Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 12, Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 13, Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 14, Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 15, Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 23, and Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block No 24, and Lots 2, 3, 6 and 7 in Block "A".

Also that part of each of the following described lots lying between the west line of North Second Street and the West line of the proposed extension thereof, being five feet in width between said lines and fifty (50) feet in length between the North and South lines of the respective lots, and each containing Two hundred and fifty (250) square feet, viz:-

The above described part of each of lots Nos 1, 5 & 8 in Block No 20, Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 19, Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 18, Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 17, Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 16, Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block No 32, and Lots Nos 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Block "A".

Also that part of fractional Lot No 2 in Block No 11, lying between the East line of North Second Street, the east line of the proposed extension thereof, the north side of said lot and the north line of "A" Street and containing one, six hundred and thirty two and eight hundredths (132.8) square feet, also that part of fractional Lot No 7 in Block "A" lying between the east line of North Second Street, the east line of the proposed extension thereof, the south line of said lot, and the west line of North Front Street, and containing one hundred and twenty five thousand six hundred, forty seven and fifty eight hundredths (125,647.58) square feet.

Also that part of fractional Lot No 1 in Block No 20 lying between the west line of North Second Street, the west line of the proposed extension thereof, the north line of said lot and the north line of "A" Street, and containing one hundred seventeen and thirty three hundredths (117.33) square feet.

Also that part of fractional Lot No 1 in Block "B" lying between the west line of North Second Street, and the west line of the proposed extension thereof, the south line of said lot, and the east line of North Front Street, and containing fifty four and fifty eight hundredths (54.58) square feet.
