— All Ordinances adopting the report of the Surveyor in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second & N. Second Streets at their intersection, and directing an entry of the assessment hereby made in the docket of City Assessors.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Dec 1 The Common Council of the City of Portland, drawing it ex parte to widen, or laterally extend the lines of Second & N. Second Streets in such manner as to make a more convenient intersection, did on the 19th day of March 1849, direct the City Surveyor to survey the same, and make his report with plan, which said report and plan was adopted by Ordinance No 24419, entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second & N. Second Streets at their intersection", Once again accordingly On the second (2nd) day of April 1849, the Common Council of the City of Portland, also appointed Mr. Burroughs, S. Morris and G. M. Giddings, Commissioners of the proposed extension, to meet at the office of the Auditor & Clerk of the City of Portland, on Saturday April 12th 1849, at 10 o'clock A.M. of which due notice was given by publication in the "Daily Bee" a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Portland, in the manner provided by law, and said commissioners having met at the time and place appointed, and being duly sworn have made said view, and their report thereof including an assessment of benefits and damages to certain property thereby specified, which said report and assessment being satisfactory to the Common Council, is hereby adopted, of which said report and assessment, the following is a copy.

The undersigned appointed viewers of the proposed lateral extension or widening of Second & N. Second Streets at their intersection in the City of Portland, by a resolution adopted by your Hon. body on the 2nd day of April A.D. 1849. Respectfully report that pursuant to said resolution and notice published in the "Daily Bee" we meet at the time and place appointed to wit, at the office of the Auditor & Clerk of the City of Portland, on Saturday April 12th 1849, at 10 o'clock A.M. of said day, and being first duly sworn and furnished with a copy of the Surveyor's report and plan of said proposed extension adopted by Ordinance No 24419, entitled "An Ordinance adopting the report of the City Surveyor in the matter of the lateral extension or widening of Second & N. Second Streets at their intersection", proceeded to view the proposed lateral extension of Second & N. Second Streets at their intersection by going over the ground and noting the exact position of the land to be affected, and upon such view, we the said viewers to assess, determine and declare the damage as well as the benefit and advantages accruing, or occasioned by the proposed lateral extension of said streets to the several pieces, parcels, or lots of land herein after set forth and described in United States gold coin as follows:
