ORDINANCE NO.6011.

An Ordinance to regulate the playing of Bands.

The City of Portland does fordain as follows;

Section 1; - That it shall be unlawful for bands to play music

or beat upon drums or cymbals while traveling from place to place

upon the streets of the City between the hours of six o'clock

P.M. and Six o'clock A.M.

Section 2;— Any person a member of any band who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance by playing upon any musical instrument or beating upon any drum or cymbal while traveling from place to place upon any of the streets of the City of Portland between the hours of six o'clock P.M. and Six o'clock A.M. of the following day shall upon conviction thereof in the Police Court be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than Fifty Dollars or be imprisoned in the City Jail for a period of time not exceeding ten days and in case any fine so imposed be not paid the offender shall be imprisoned in the City Jail until such fine be paid for the period of one day for each two dollars of such fine.
