Ordinance No. 16330.

An ordinance adopting the report of the City Engineer in the matter of the proposed extension of East Nineteenth Street, from the south line of Rowell Street to the south line of Edgar Street extended easterly.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Portland deeming it expedient to extend East Nineteenth Street from the south line of Powell Street to the south line of Edgar Street extended easterly did, on the 6th day of February, 1907, direct the City Engineer to survey the same, and to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make a plat of such survey, and a written report containing a full and perfect description of such proposed street and the boundaries thereof and of the portion of each lot, tract, or part of either to be appropriated for such street and the City Engineer having made such survey, plat and report and filed

such plat and report in the office of the Auditor of the City of Portland on the 25th day of February, 1907, and the said plat and report being satisfactory to the Council, is now hereby adopted, of which report of D. W. Taylor, City Engineer, the following is a copy, to-wit:

Portland, Oregon, Feb. 25, 1907.

TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND:

Gentlemen:-

In pursuance of a resolution adopted by your Honorable Body at your meeting of February 6th, 1907, directing me to survey and mark the boundaries of the proposed extension of East Nineteenth Street southerly in its present course and width from the south line of Powell Street to the south line of Edgar Street extended easterly, I have surveyed and marked the boundaries of the proposed extension of East 19th Street and herein submit my report together with a plat of said survey.

The proposed extension of East 19th Street is 60 feet in width and is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the south line of Powell Street where the same is intersected by the west line of East Nineteenth Street extended southerly and running thence southerly along said extension to the south line of Edgar Street; thence easterly along the south line of Edgar Street and an extension thereof 60 feet; thence northerly 60 feet distant from and parallel with the west line of the proposed extension of East 19th Street as above described, to the south line of Powell Street; thence along the south line of Powell Street to the place of beginning.

The proposed extension of East 19th Street as above described will include and necessitate the appropriation to public use the following described parcels or tracts of land, to-wit:

All that part of Lot 1, Block 2 of Subdivision of Block 2, of Smith's Subdivision and Addition to East Portland lying east of the west line of the proposed extension of East 19th Street as above described containing 2984 square feet.

Also all that part of Lot 18, Block 2 of Subdivision of Block 2, of Smith's Subdivision and Addition to East Portland lying east of the west line of the proposed extension of East 19th Street as above described, containing 3000 square feet.

Also all that parcel or tract of land bounded on the north by the south line of Powell Street, on the south by the south line of Edgar Street extended easterly, on the east by the east line of the proposed extension of East 19th Street as above described and on the west by the east line of Block 2 Smith's Subdivision and Addition to East Portland, containing 6933 square feet.
