

An Ordinance taking over a County Road known as Barnes Road, from 240 feet west of the east line of City Park extended northerly to the west line of Kings Heights extended southerly, as a City Street.

WHEREAS, the County Court of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, on April 25th, 1910, surrendered a County Road known as Barnes Road, from 240 feet west of the east line of City Park extended northerly to the west line of Kings Heights extended southerly, to the City of Portland as and for a City Street; Therefore

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a County Road known as Barnes Road, from 240 feet west of the east line of City Park extended northerly to the west line of Kings Heights extended southerly be and the same is hereby taken over and established as a City Street, as described, in the report of the City Engineer, adopted by Ordinance No. 21034.
