

Ordinance No. 22861.

An Ordinance providing for the appointment of a Grappler to be under the supervision of the Harbormaster, fixing the salary thereof, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Portland, subject to the Civil Service rules of the Charter of said City, a Grappler who shall be subject to the orders of the Harbormaster of the City of Portland.

Section 2. The salary of said Grappler shall be the sum of eighty dollars, (\$80.00) per month, payable monthly as other salaries are paid.

Section 3. That the sum of \$854.30 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund to provide for the payment of the salary of the salary of the Grappler mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Portland and the inhabitants thereof in this: That there are many persons being drowned in the Willamette River and no person now in the employ of the City of Portland is competent to grapple for such bodies, and it is necessary to secure the employment of a person familiar with

such work, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
