

Ordinance No. 23057

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Auditor to break the seals on ballot boxes, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to use the ballot boxes provided for the election held in November, 1910, for the coming primary and general elections; therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and is hereby authorized and directed to break the seals on such ballot boxes as may be required for use in the coming primary and general elections.

Section 2. Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Portland for the following reasons: It is necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the City Charter providing for elections that these ballot boxes be opened immediately in order that they may be properly prepared for said elections. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
