

An ordinance granting a revocable permit to E. A. Baldwin to construct a fuel oil tank under the sidewalk on the North side of Hawthorne Avenue, 80 feet West of Grand Avenue.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That a revocable permit be and is hereby granted to Mr. E. A. Baldwin to construct a fuel oil tank under the side walk in Lot 5, Block 92, this city and more fully described as the Northwest Corner of Grand Avenue and Hawthorne Avenue.

Section 2. Said oil tank shall be placed and constructed satisfactory to the City Engineer and Fire Marshal of the City of Portland and be removed when so ordered by the Council of the City of Portland and the street or sidewalk put in proper condition.

Section 3. Said E. A. Baldwin shall file a bond, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Portland, in the sum of \$500.00, conditioned that the provisions of this ordinance will be complied with in all respects.
