ORDINANCE No. 115219

An Ordinance authorizing purchase of four elephants and unborn calf for the sum of \$30,000 from H. Morgan Berry, 8615 Meridian Avenue, Seattle, Washington, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a trustee check, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that H. Morgan Berry, 8615 Meridian Avenue, Seattle, Washington, orally offered to sell to the City an elephant cow named Belle, age 10 years, her calf, Packy, born April 14, 1962 at the Portland Zoological Gardens in Portland, Oregon, an elephant cow named Pet, age 7 years and her unborn calf, and an elephant bull named Thonglaw, age 14 years, all for the total sum of \$30,000; that donations have been made from individuals and organizations in excess of \$30,000 for the purchase of the aforementioned elephants for the Portland Zoological Gardens; that said money donated is held by the City Treasurer in the "Jack Marks Elephant Fund, Trustee Account," and that the purchase of said elephants should be authorized; now, therefore, the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks hereby is authorized and directed to purchase from H. Morgan Berry, 8615 Meridian Avenue, Seattle, Washington, an elephant cow named Belle, age 10 years, her calf, Packy, born April 14, 1962, at the Portland Zoological Gardens in Portland, Oregon, an elephant cow named Pet, age 7 years and her unborn calf, and an elephant bull named Thonglaw, age 14 years, for the Portland Zoological Gardens, for the total sum of \$30,000.00; that the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to draw a trustee check payable to H. Morgan Berry, 8615 Meridian Avenue, Seattle, Washington, in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the "Jack Marks Elephant Fund, Trustee Account," and the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks hereby is authorized to deliver said trustee check to H. Morgan Berry upon receipt of an appropriate bill of sale approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the purchase provided for in Section 1 hereof may be made without unnecessary delay, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
