

Description:

14 Reconditioned FM two-way radios, "T" power, model number U43GGT-1100 series, rear mount, 25 watt RF power, 12V DC operation, negative ground, 30kc. channel spacing, dual frequency transmitter, dual frequency receiver.

Channel one on receiver to be phased on 155.190MC., channel two on 155.130MC.
Channel one on transmitter to be phased on 159.210MC., channel two on 158.910MC.

Crystals NOT TO BE SHIPPED WITH RADIOS, but to be supplied when vendor is notified of exact frequency.

Each set to be supplied with control head with microphone connector, carbon microphone with four-prong plug, speaker, 12volt cable kit, roof-top antenna and installation kit.

ORDINANCE No. 125127


An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of 14 reconditioned 2-way radios by the Bureau of Communications and Electronics without advertising for bids, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds that there are available 14 reconditioned 2-way radios which may be obtained from Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., 8665 SW Canyon Road, Portland, Oregon 97225, at the price of \$425 each; that the said equipment may be readily integrated into the existing radio system of the City of Portland and inasmuch as similar equipment cannot be obtained from other manufacturers or dealers there is no benefit to be derived from advertising for the said equipment; now, therefore, the purchase of 14 reconditioned 2-way radios, "T" power, model number U43GGT-1100 series, rear mount, 25 watt RF power, 12V DC operation, negative ground, 30kc. channel spacing, dual frequency transmitter, dual frequency receiver, for an agreed price of \$425 each, for the use and benefit of the Bureau of Communications and Electronics, hereby is authorized, and the Mayor and Auditor are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in payment for the said equipment, the said warrant to be drawn against and charged to the appropriation General Fund, Bureau of Communications and Electronics (200.720).

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no delay in obtaining the needed equipment, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
