## **ORDINANCE NO. 184103**

Authorize contract with Murray, Smith & Associates, Inc. for the design of the Fulton Pump Station Replacement project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland Water Bureau (PWB) requires consultant services for the design of the Fulton Pump Station Replacement project. The new 18 million gallon per day (mgd) pump station will replace the existing station which is over 90 years old. The new station will also have the ability to pump from a higher-pressure water source which is expected to result in more efficient pumping and less electricity use.
- 2. Request for Proposal WTR 085 was advertised as part of the formal competitive solicitation process in accordance with the City Code for Professional Services Contracts.
- 3. \$343,857, or approximately 24.3%, of the contract dollars will be awarded to State of Oregon certified Minority, Women, and Emerging Small Businesses.
- 4. The not to exceed value of the contract is \$1,413,741. The Confidence Level for this contract is Optimal. Funding for the project is available in the FY 2010-11 Budget and will be requested in the FY 2011-12 through FY 2014-15 Budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute on behalf of the City a contract with Murray, Smith and Associates, Inc. in a form in accordance with the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund, Account 521000, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
