ORDINANCE NO. 150512

An Ordinance increasing resources and requirements in the General Fund, increasing appropriations in the Bureau of Economic Development; and transferring appropriations from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering in the amount of \$5.520 each in support of the Greeley/I=5 business relocation project; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149695, the Council authorized an agreement between the City and the Highway Division of the Oregon Department of Transportation providing for payment of City costs for carrying out relocation assistance for businesses displaced by construction of the Greeley/I-5 Ramp Connections.
- 2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 149695, the Council authorized the Bureau of Economic Development to perform relocation advisory assistance to firms being displaced by the Greeley/I-5 project.
- 3. Total costs for the relocation advisory assistance are estimated at \$\$6,000. The Highway Division of the Oregon Department of Transportaion will reimburse the City for 92 percent of project costs, or \$5,520. The City's share of this project is \$480 and is availabe from HCD funds in the Bureau of Economic Development's FY 1980-81 budget.
- 4. It is now appropriate to increase appropriations in the Bureau of Economic Development and the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering to reflect the inter-agency agreement between these two bureaus.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Resources and requirements of the FY 1980-81 City budget are amended as follows:
