## **ORDINANCE No.** 184435

\* Accept and appropriate the Healthy People, Healthy Places grant in the amount of \$35,000 from the Multnomah County Health Department for Safe Routes to School policy development (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Transportation applied to the Multnomah County Health Department for a Healthy People, Healthy Places grant in the amount of \$35,000 for Safe Routes to School policy development on December 1, 2010; and
- 2. The Multnomah County Health Department has notified the City of Portland that it will award a Healthy People, Healthy Places grant for Safe Routes to School policy development to the Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$35,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland the Healthy People, Healthy Places grant from the Multnomah County Health Department for the Safe Routes to School policy development in the amount of \$35,000.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217 Business Area – TR00 Bureau Program Expenses– \$35,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Transportation of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Multnomah County Health Department for Healthy People, Healthy Places grant, award number CPPW10-001, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
