

## ORDINANCE No. 184497

Authorize a contract and provide for payment for the construction of the Mason Flats Wetland Enhancement Project No. E07155 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Mason Flats Wetland Enhancement Project will improve stormwater quality, the water quality of the Columbia Slough, and habitat for the Willow Flycatcher, Redlegged Frog, and Western Painted Turtle. These species occur in the project area and are listed as State Critical Sensitive.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for enhancing the stormwater treatment properties and wildlife habitat of the Mason Flats wetland.
3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
4. The estimated cost is \$900,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is high. Funds are available in the Bureau of Environmental Services Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011, Project No. E07155.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
