### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Russ Gilbert was a long-time employee with the Maintenance Bureau who is now retired after being placed on medical lay off status. He disputed the application of certain HR Administrative Rules regarding sick leave and FMLA. At one point, time charged as sick time was reversed and taken as vacation leave, against Mr. Gilbert's will. This settlement would repay Mr. Gilbert for that lost vacation time, an additional one month's salary as penalty wages provided by Oregon statutes and part of his attorney's fees for a total settlement of \$50,000.

This represents a compromise with Mr. Gilbert who brought a lawsuit against the city for more than \$1 million arguing that he was entitled to cash out his remaining accumulated sick leave upon retirement and that he had been retaliated against and forced into early retirement.

#### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$14,250 from the liability fund and a payroll payment from PBOT in the gross amount of \$35,750.

### 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Russ Gilbert's claim in the sum of \$50,000.
