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ORDINANCE No. 184707

Improve the appeals process for public works permitting (Ordinance; amend City Code Section 17.06.050)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. City Council Section 17.06.050 sets forth an appeals process for public works permitting. The code provisions include a 15-day deadline for the filing of appeals.
2. During 2010 and 2011, the City's public works bureaus have been working with local development professionals and development stakeholders to test out the appeals procedures set forth in Section 17.06.050.
3. The public works bureaus, local development professionals and development stakeholders have determined that the public works permitting process requires a more adaptive appeals process that better serves the public works permitting reforms adopted by Council in 2009 and 2010.


