

An ordinance authorizing the procuring of a parcel of land for a cemetery, and improving the same,

Whereas James Terrilliger and Minnie Caruthers have agreed, upon certain conditions to grant to the City of Portland ten acres of land for a cemetery, and the same having been accepted, Therefore the People of the City of Portland do ordain as follows

Sec 1 That the Committee on Streets Public Buildings and Improvement, together with the Mayor be and they are hereby authorized and required to enter into an agreement in the name of the City of Portland with James Terrilliger and Minnie Caruthers for the purpose of procuring from them ten acres of land for a cemetery -

Sec 2 That the sum of Four Hundred Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the use of said Committee and the Mayor for the purpose of carrying ^{into} effect such agreement

Sec 3 That for the purpose of carrying into effect the above named agreement the Committee on Streets Public Buildings and Improvement together with the Mayor be and they are hereby authorized and required to have surveyed and laid off out into lots of a proper size for family burial lots so much of said land as may be conveyed to the City of Portland by said Terrilliger and Caruthers

as can be sold at a price not less than \$25.00 per lot, provided that one fourth of the whole of said ten acres of land shall be set apart and used as a public burial ground -

Sec 4 That for the purpose of ^{carrying into effect} said agreement the Committee on streets Public buildings and Improvements together with the Mayor be and they are hereby authorized and required to sell or caused to be sold at Public auction on or before the first day of October next as many of said lots so layed off as will bring the price named in section third of this ordinance, provided that one of the lots so layed off shall be granted and conveyed unto the said James Terwilliger and one to Minnie Caruthers and that said Committee together with the Mayor are further authorized to sell at any and all times upon application any lot so layed off by them -

Sec 5 That the Committee on streets Public buildings and Improvements together with the Mayor be and they are hereby authorized and required to enclose said land with a good and substantial board fence not less than five feet high, said fence to be paid for by said Committee and the Mayor out of the proceeds received by them from the sale of said lot, the remainder of the proceeds thereof to be applied to the improvement and ornamenting of said Cemetery

Sec 6 That the Committee on streets public buildings and improvements together with the Mayor are required to make a report of their proceedings in writing to the Common Council upon the 1st Monday of January April July and October of each year.

Sec 7 That Ordinance Number Eight Entitled an ordinance authorizing the purchase of a parcel of land for a cemetery enclosing the Cemetery and clearing a path of the same, be and the same is hereby repealed -

Sec 8 This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its approval by the Mayor -
