## **ORDINANCE No.** 184857

\*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County and accept additional grant funds in the amount of \$15,000 for Communities Putting Prevention to Work provided through American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001619)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability submitted a proposal in the amount of \$200,000 to Multnomah County to be included in the County's application to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention for a *Communities Putting Prevention to Work* grant provided through American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) 2009.
- 2. Multnomah County was awarded a \$7.5 million grant from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. By Ordinance No. 184019 on July 28, 2010 the City accepted a grant from Multnomah County in the amount of \$175,000f or Community Putting People to Work project. The County has notified the City of Portland that it will provide additional grants funds for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$15,000 to develop purchasing policies related to wellness in the workplace.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor on behalf of the City of Portland is hereby authorized to amend City Grant. No. PN000020, County Contract No. 4600008374, for the *Communities Putting Prevention to Work* project, to accept funds in the amount of \$15,000 and to sign an amendment to the intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of attached Exhibit A for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2011-12 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217001 Business Area – PN00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$15,000

c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that there be no delay performing services on behalf of the County's grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
