CHANGES TO ORIGINAL SUBMITTAL (dated October 18, 2011)

On October 25, 2011, the Planning and Sustainability Commission will hold a hearing on Minor Amendments to the City of Portland's Transportation System Plan (TSP), part of the City's Comprehensive Plan. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) staff proposes that the Planning and Sustainability Commission recommend that City Council amend the City of Portland's TSP to update a limited number of street segment classifications and TSP projects based on the Land Use Final Order for the Portland Milwaukee Light Rail Project.

Proposed Changes to Original Submittal

During the public review and staff comment period, a number of modifications were proposed. Most of these modifications were added to our submittal dated October 18, 2001. One comment for SW Moody bike classification was not captured in our packet. The modification is attached as a matrix and a new map.

We have modified the Planning and Sustainability Commission action. New language is attached in the 'Motion Memo'.
