## ORDINANCE No. 185094

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to define the roles and responsibilities for real property to be obtained and used as part of right-of-way for road, street or construction of public improvements for the NE/SE 50s Bikeway Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On June 28, 2006, Council adopted Resolution 36422 that authorized the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) to submit for the 2008-11 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) funding.
- In 2009, PBOT was awarded a \$1.52M MTIP grant to build the 50's Bikeway. The 50's Bikeway project will design and construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements along SE 52<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and NE 53<sup>rd</sup> between SE Woodstock Boulevard and NE Thompson Street.
- 3. On September 29, 2011, Council adopted Resolution #36882 to accept the recommendations developed by the project's Citizens Advisory Committee and to commence the design engineering and right-of-way phases of the project.
- 4. This Agreement clarifies PBOT's obligations for acquiring the right-of-way necessary to construct the project with federal funds.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The cost estimate for the design and construction will be developed during the development phase.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.
