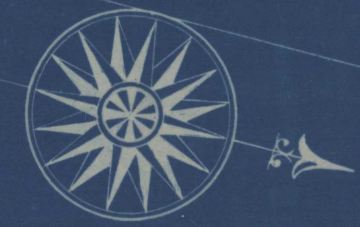


MAP OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND

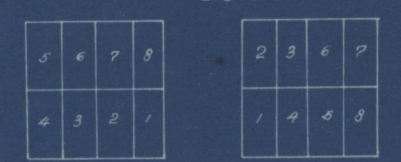

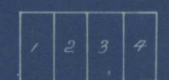


Order of Numbering Lots.

Couch Claim east of Front S1.

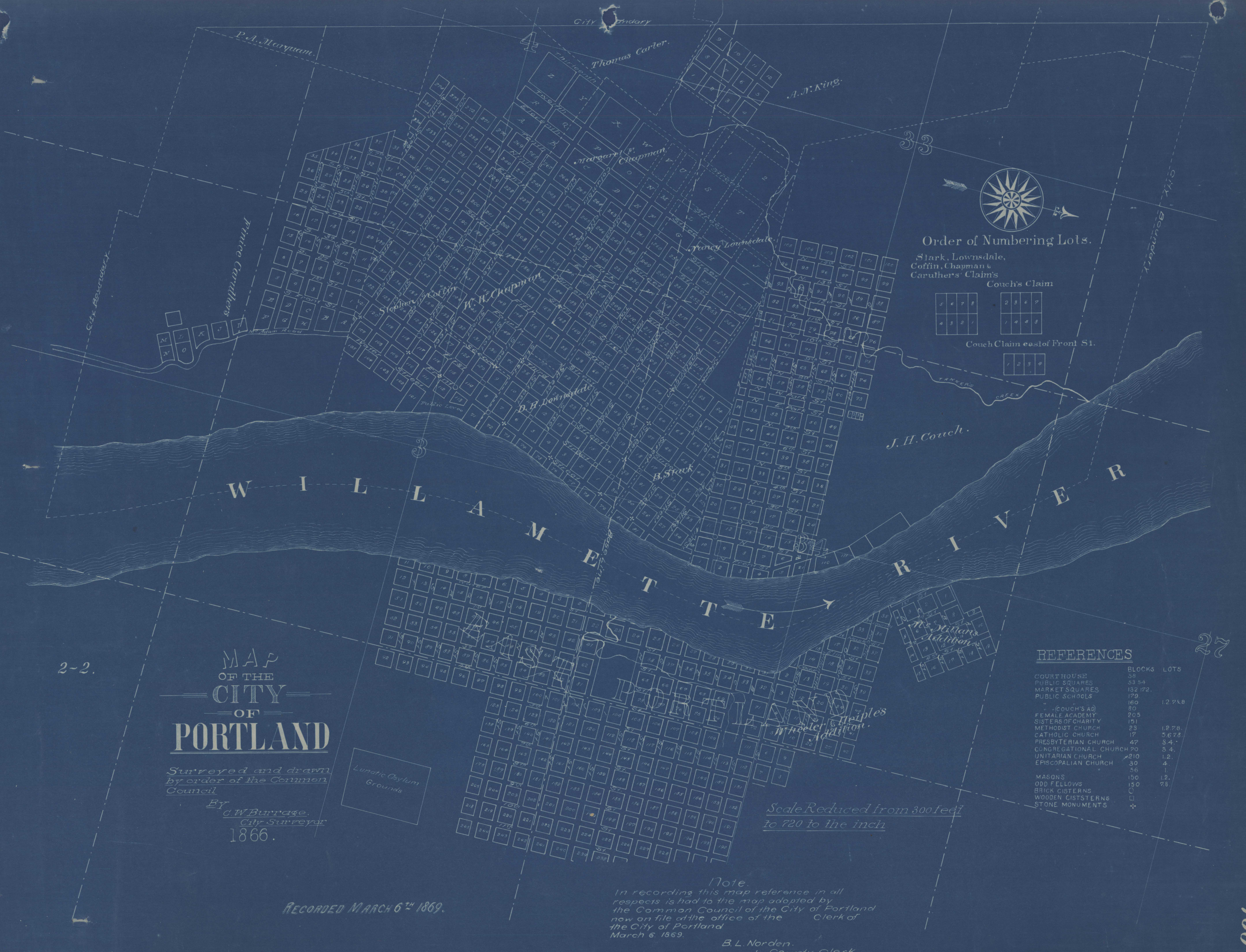
