TO THE COUNCIL:

Due to the advanced age and increasing maintenance and repair costs incurred by two of the current in-service fireboats Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) requires their replacement as they will reach the end of their useful life over the next five years. In preparation for these replacements Jensen Maritime Consultants created the specifications and Outboard Profile and General Arrangements under contract 30002110. With the passage of Ordinance 184966, PF&R received Council authorization to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) resulting in a not-to-exceed contract.

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received Offers under Request for Proposals (RFP) 113535, for the construction of two 50' aluminum fireboats. The RFP was issued on October 19, 2011 and three proposals were received. The proposals were reviewed, evaluated and scored in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33. Oregon Iron Works, Inc. received the highest evaluation score and was identified as the most qualified respondent from an independent evaluation committee. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Negotiate and Award a Contract to Oregon Iron Works, Inc. on January 23, 2012 and the City received no opposing comments. The estimated replacement cost for each fireboat is \$2,506,638.50, for a total cost of \$5,013,277.00.

Oregon Iron Works, Inc. has a current City of Portland business license and is in compliance with the Equal Benefits Program; their EEO Certification is current through October 31, 2012. The company is located in Clackamas, Oregon and is not an Oregon state certified MWESB contractor. Confidence in the cost estimate for this equipment is High, as the final contract will include a firm negotiated price from the manufacturer.

General Obligation Bond funds authorized by the citizens of Portland in the November 2010 election will be used to pay for the purchase of the two fireboats.

The Chief Procurement Officer recommends the Council authorize a contract be executed with Oregon Iron Works, Inc. for the two 50' aluminum hull fireboats as described above in a form substantially in conformance with the contract attached as Exhibit A.
