- Page 7, equity (add "age" to description of Portland's increasing diversity): "Portland is becoming a more racially and, ethnically, and age diverse city with more newcomers."
- 3. **Page 16 add**: "Portland has been named on at least two national lists as one of the best places to retire."
- 4. **Page 17 add:** New statement about budget challenges for public transportation.
- 5. ***Page 87, Action 75:** Replace "elderly and disabled people" with the terms "elders and people with disabilities".
