Present regulations more clearly

#4) <u>Clarify and expand Table 40-1:</u> Present regulations more clearly



Address Unintended Consequences #1, #3, #7

#1) <u>Amend Process for Updating Title 11</u>: Add a third tier of amendments: Conforming Amendments

#3) <u>Eliminate Street Tree Removal Minimum Size</u> <u>Threshold:</u>

Maintain existing policy for street tree removal Clarify that sucker shoots and small self-sown trees do not require a permit

#7) <u>Modify Enforcement Tools to Provide More</u> Options

Add tools to back into regulations to allow staff to issue penalties to tree removal companies

Technical Amendments: #5 and #6

#5) Modify Tree Permit Summary Table 40-2 and <u>40-3</u>: Tables are re-formatted and modified to reflect changes in amendments 2, 3, and 6

#6) <u>Correct References and Typos, Replace</u> inconsistent Terminology



Technical Amendments: #8

#8) <u>Title 33, Planning and Zoning:</u> Rescind Conflicting Zoning Code Amendment to account for changes made with the Airport Futures Project currently in effect.

- Will maintain Airport Futures Project regulations
- No effect on Tree Code policies

Urban Forestry Commission Recommendation

- Forward to City Council with added direction:
 - Track and monitor Street Tree Removal Permits
 - Track and monitor Private Tree Removals
 - Monitor effectiveness of on-line Street Tree pruning permits and size threshold
 - Clarify terminology in code amendment commentary
 - Produce easy-to-understand outreach materials for subsequent code administration
