Attached is a report of the results of the Downtown Vision Task Force's 2009 Downtown Retail Strategy. The Task Force operated throughout 2009 under the mission

"to define a street or streets where initial efforts are focused to create a destination location that will draw customers downtown... to recognize that a healthy downtown acts as a cornerstone for a strong regional economy... and through improving downtown, we will support job growth, an increased tax base, and an attractive destination..."

The presentation will be delivered by Cori Jacobs (Downtown Retail Advocate), Dave Leland (Leland Consulting), and Tad Savinar (Chair of the Task Force). They will present the Strategy's major findings and recommendations for moving forward on an effective and strategic workplan to enhance Portland's downtown retail core.
