Matt Dhillon, Chuck Mello, Jim Ferris, and Jeanette McLearn's terms expired in August 2008. However, they have continued to serve on the Electrical Board of Appeal since that time. The board meets approximately once or twice a year. I am recommending **Matt Dhillon** move from the Electrical Engineer alternate position to the Electrical Engineer position replacing Chuck Mello. I am recommending **Jim Ferris** continue as the Electrical Contractor member. Chuck Mello and Jeanette McLearn (alternate) have completed their terms. Matt Dhillon and Jim Ferris' terms will expire on August 31, 2011.

#### New Appointment
