Based upon the initial work of the Disparity Study Advisory Group the City Council adopted Resolution 36868 in June 2011 directing staff to work with the Fair Contracting Forum and other interested organizations and stakeholders to review the data provided by the 2009 Disparity Study and to bring forward recommendations to expand and strengthen equity in the City's procurement and contracting programs. Over 40 meetings were convened with over 85 diverse participants including contractors, consultants, and representatives from a variety of community and professional organizations.

 Recommendations in five programmatic areas: contractor workforce, subcontracting, prequalification, a new prime contracting program and professional, technical and expert services were brought forward by the workgroups.
