

ORDINANCE No. 185562

Authorize a grant to provide First Stop Portland, a program of the College of Urban and Public Affairs at Portland State University, \$15,000 to help pay for costs associated with its program operations. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

The Council finds that:

1. The City of Portland is widely recognized as a leader in sustainable placemaking; and
2. First Stop Portland's study tour-based sustainability program has been an important asset for Portland by focusing on sharing Portland's best practices around central city vitality, multimodal transportation solutions, resource land protection, sustainable development, and true community involvement; and
3. First Stop Portland of Portland State University connects visitors from around the world with Portland's experts, leaders and innovators in business and politics who know Portland's sustainability story best; and
4. First Stop Portland provides the planning and logistical support for these visiting delegations interested in learning about Portland's sustainable policies and practices; and
5. City Council supported the allocation of \$15,000 in the FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget to provide First Stop Portland financial assistance to implement their tour-based programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement, as outlined in form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrant chargeable to the FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget when demand is presented and properly approved by the proper authority.


