

ORDINANCE No. 185569

Repeal outdated sections of Code addressing responsibilities for the Civic Stadium (Ordinance; repeal Code Sections 3.26.060, 3.106.070, and 20.28.010)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:


1. City Code, Title 3 – Administration, Section 3.26.060 – Municipal Stadium Division assigns responsibility for the municipal (civic) stadium to the Parks Bureau.
2. City Code 3.106 – Exposition and Recreation Commission, Section 3.106.070 – Special Services Personnel as Special Police allows certain personnel to be authorized to issue citations for parking or non-moving traffic violations occurring on or around the premises of the Memorial Coliseum and Civic Stadium.
3. City Code, Title 20 – Parks, Section 20.28.010 – Basic Rental Charges outlines policies governing the rental charges for the Civic Stadium.
4. On July 23, 2009, through Ordinance #183036, City Council authorized a sole source acquisition and execution of a contract with Peregrine Sports, LLC for Predevelopment Agreement and Operating Agreement for a Major League Soccer Stadium. This contract is managed by the Office of Management and Finance, Spectator Facilities division.
5. The naming rights for Civic Stadium were initially purchased by Portland General Electric, naming the stadium PGE Park and in 2011 by Jeld Wen, naming the stadium Jeld Wen Field.
6. Parks and MERC no longer have responsibilities for Civic Stadium. Since 1993, MERC no longer has responsibilities for Memorial Coliseum.
7. The aforementioned sections of City Code are out-of-date and should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Repeal City Code Section 3.26.060 Municipal Stadium Division
- b. Repeal City Code Section 3.106.070 Special Services Personnel as Special Police
- c. Repeal City Code Section 20.28.010 Basic Rental Charges
